

Tender Invite for Development Worker for Dunadd Community Enterprise

This will entail identifying and applying for funding, writing and coordinating feasibility studies and, working with partner organisations and the board of directors.

The initial projects have been identified through community consultation, which produced a community plan, the details of which are available via our website. The directors have identified the following projects as the initial priorities.

- Feasibility of renovation and community use of Kilmartin church
- A micro-hydro system
- A market garden/allotment project

The person appointed will need to have relevant experience in project development and management, be able to build partnerships with other agencies and use a community development approach to assist in developing and implementing trust projects.

Tenders need to show compliance with the brief, experience relevant to the contract and schedule of work, two references, and costs based on 24 hours per week for 12 months.
