## Dunadd Community Enterprise AGM Thursday 26<sup>th</sup> January Chair's Report

The last year was still a COVID year and has seen us finish the Lockdown recovery project. Initially we were looking at taking over the responsibility of the public toilets in Kilmartin, but Argyll & Bute managed to gain funding to keep this going themselves. We bought a community 'stretch' tent which we used to help local business sell their products and well as local groups using it as a meeting place.

We now have a community stretch tent 8\*10 meters in size that local groups can use, we only ask that the group has public liability insurance for the tent use and the people to erect it.

During the year we were asked by a local group to explore sharing public liability insurance costs, by seeing if we could have an area cover. This turned out to be too difficult, as we would have to create quite a bureaucratic system to enable this.

We have worked alongside the Community Council to update the community plan, the results of which will be discussed at the next community council meeting.

Last year I was talking about the difficulty we been having in finding funding for an administrator. This year I have been in discussion with the A'Chruach Wind Farm, Community Fund and have a direction we can take, the first step is for the joint work to be completed on the updated Community Plan.

I would like to thank all the directors or their work over the last year.
